STODDARD COUNTY CAREER LEARNING CENTER

The Stoddard County Career Learning Center moved their classrooms to the Bootheel Regional Planning and Economic Development Commissions' office in January 2008.

On January 7, 2008, the diesel mechanics classes began. Classes are held Monday-Thursday each week for six weeks.

The Stoddard County Career Learning Center was established in 2003 as a training facility for Stoddard County residents and the surrounding counties to provide wider career opportunities and increased earning potential.

The Learning Center is certified to operate by the Missouri Coordinating Board for Higher Education and has met the WIA certification requirements and is eligible to receive funds from WIA, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), Trade Act (TAA-NAFTA) and Parents' Fair Share (PFS).

Admission Requirements:

The Stoddard County Career Learning Center is interested in students with a desire to succeed. To be admitted, a student must be 16 years or older to register for classes unless otherwise noted and meet the prerequisite(s) listed for each class. If the student is a minor, a parent or legal guardian must sign registration.

Students must be high school graduates or have a General Education Development Certificate (GED).

Stoddard County Career Learning Center ensures that equal educational opportunities are offered to students regardless of race, creed, color, sex, religion, national origin/ancestry, disability, sexual preference or age.

A Certificate of Completion is issued for each course after successfully completing the program of study.

Tuition for most classes can be paid on weekly installments.
