Separate sealed bids for the construction of improvements to the Westside Willis Conner Industrial Park to serve the City of Dexter, Missouri, will be received by the City Clerk, City Hall, until 2:00 PM (local time) on July 7, 2009, and then at said office publicly opened and read aloud.

The project shall consist of furnishing and installing:

A 12 feet wide asphalt turn lane and 12 feet wide truck staging area alongside the existing north lane of Arvin Road at the main entrance to Emcon Technologies in the Westside Willis Conner Industrial Park. The project consists of excavation work including compaction of subsoil, compacted granular base, asphalt paving, compacted soil backfill, and site work. The new lane and staging area will be approximately 1,300 feet long. Also including will be the height adjustment of two manhole frames and covers to match the new pavement surface.

All wages paid for work under this Contract shall comply with requirements of the prevailing wage law of the State of Missouri, Sec. 290.210 through 290.340, RSMO 1978, as amended or current Federal prevailing wage rates (whichever is higher).

Attention of bidders is particularly called to the requirements as to conditions of employment to be observed and minimum wage rates to be paid under the contract, Section 3, Segregated Facility, Section 109, and Executive Order 11246.
